#### 1. Welcome

The Vice Chairperson welcomed the members and apologies were noted. A Rodgers confirmed that Cork City Council are in the process of establishing a new directorate called Community, Culture and Place Making and that the Director (A Rodgers) will be appointed as new LCDC Chief Officer.

# 2. Minutes

The minutes of 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2019 were considered and on proposal of Cllr C. O'Leary, seconded by Cllr PJ Hourican were approved with no matters arising.

#### 3. Correspondence

T Power noted the following correspondence was received from the Department of Rural and Community Development:

- 1. An invitation to stakeholder consultation events on Rural Policy. T Power to circulate email to members.
- 2. Confirmation that the review of the LECP is to be deferred until later in the year.
- 3. Draft LCDC Review. Recommendations from this review will be implemented from Q4.

T Power invited members to the Big Hello (National Community Weekend) events and to the Launch of LGBTI week on Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> May.

### 4. Funding Streams Update

## a) Healthy Ireland Fund 2018

T Power noted that Healthy Ireland Round 2 Actions are ongoing.

## b) National Community Weekend - May, 2019

T Power confirmed that National Community Weekend Event funding had been paid. A final list of approved grants totalling €15,000 was circulated to members.

## c) Community Enhancement Programme (CEP) 2019

T Power confirmed that the CEP 2019 will be advertised on 17<sup>th</sup> May and that a joint advertisement will issue from both Cork City and Council LCDC's. The advert will include information in relation to the transition area.

R Loughry confirmed workshop details for Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> May.

#### 5. SICAP

## **Boundary Extension**

R Loughry confirmed that the draft Service Level Agreement (SLA) between Cork City LCDC and South Cork LCDC will be circulated to members for comment. SLA to be signed by Chief Officer and Chair of each LCDC by the end of May. A committee will be formed to monitor the SICAP programme in the transition area for the duration of the current contract.
