Introduction

The Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010 introduced requirements for a more evidenced based approach to the Development Plan making process. This includes a requirement for Core Strategies setting out how national and regional population targets are distributed at community and neighbourhood level. Section 10 of the Act also requires Plans to set out statutory objectives, including objectives to deliver community development and services, local transport provision, employment and educational services and climate action and adaption measures.

To deliver on these statutory requirements, Cork City's Development Plan needs to fully consider the socio-economic profile of all existing local communities and neighbourhoods within the City. This understanding allows for the better delivery of local objectives and actions. It is also central to achieving the vision set out in the Action Programme for Effective Local Government; *"that local government will be the main vehicle of governance and public service at local level, leading economic, social and community development".*

As part of the Development Plan making process Cork City Council have engaged the All-Island Research Observatory (AIRO) to provide valuable overview and insight of the socioeconomic characteristics within the City. As part of this work, the Cork City Neighbourhood Profile has used a collaborative approach to provide a very detailed set of comparative indicators and profiles for all neighbourhoods and communities in the City.

The report allows for a much richer understanding of the wide ranging and differing characteristics within the City's network of neighbourhoods and communities. This understanding has helped inform background studies and analysis and the formulation goals and objectives for neighbourhood development within the Plan.

How to Use this Report

This report is designed to enable users to gain a deeper understanding of Cork City's network of neighbourhoods and communities. The report is broken down into two sections. The first section provides a comparative overview of all neighbourhoods by using a series of key indicators. The second section provides a detailed analysis of each individual neighbourhood by using a wider set of indicators.

Section 1 (Comparative Analysis) highlights the variety of neighbourhoods within the city by benchmarking various indicators. Maps and bar charts apply geographies and neighbourhoods to illustrate differences between areas. Each map and bar chart is based on a different key indicator, including demographic profile, housing and employment. Collectively this comparative analysis provides a wider understanding of the differing socio-economic characteristics within the overall distribution of neighbourhoods across the city.

Section 2 (Neighbourhood Profiles) contains an individual profile for each of the City's 44 neighbourhoods and community's that collectively form Cork City. Each profile uses a range of census data benchmarked against the Cork City average, to present a socio-economic overview of that place. Each profile includes a range of indicators including housing tenure, employment types and education levels. An analysis of commuting flows in and out of each neighbourhood is provided. Details on the levels of employment versus number of jobs in each neighbourhood is also given. The profiles provide a user-friendly evidence-based snapshot for each neighbourhood.





Methodology Applied

To strengthen our communities, it is important that our neighbourhoods are thoughtfully planned for in a coordinated, place-based way. Creating walkable, liveable neighbourhoods, connects people to these places, and in turn promotes healthy, active lifestyles for all. To help achieve this, the Cork City Development Plan applies the 15 minute city concept a core principle within the Plan. The 15-minute neighbourhood is all about enabling people to live locally. The goal is to enable people to get where they need to go to as part of their everyday lives within a 15-minute walk, roll, or bus. These every day needs include places like public parks, libraries, schools, childcare, shops, or cafés.

During the initial stages of the Cork City Development Plan process, a socio-economic profile was produced for Cork City. This profile is based on data derived from the 2016 Census and presented series of detailed maps and graphics illustrating the comparative analysis of the Cork City area and its suburbs. Based on a broad range of socio-economic indicators, this report was a great step forward in providing a better understanding of the recently expanded administrative area of the city.

While this initial study provided a broad overview and understanding of the city area, it was clear that a more detailed assessment at neighbourhood and community level was needed. There were two core aims in delivering this assessment. Firstly, to highlight the nuance and differing needs associated with local areas within the city, which could inform policy makers going forward. Secondly, to present socio-economic data at a tangible local scale (neighbourhoods) to help enhance public engagement and provide a better understanding of the policy and decision-making processes.

Until the development of this report there had been no attempt, to date, to clearly define the multitude of neighbourhoods that make up Cork City. The project team undertook a methodical staged process, using a combination of zoning classifications, geospatial analysis and local level and expert consultation to define 44 neighbourhoods. This process was underpinned by the assignment of CSO Census (Small Area) geographies to each neighbourhood. By aligning each neighbourhood to the CSO Census output geographies, the team were able to undertake a detailed socio-economic assessment of each neighbourhood. The following process outlines the stages used to define Cork City's 44 neighbourhoods:

• **Stage 1 (Baseline Assessment):** This included an assessment of zoning maps, desk surveys and site surveys to establish the existing community and neighbourhood centres in the city. The location and extent of these centres were confirmed through collaboration with a number of other sections in the council.

• **Stage 2 (Initial Draft):** The existing local, neighbourhood, and district centres were mapped using a Geographic Information System (GIS). From these centres, a circular buffer of 800m equivalent of a 10-minute walk was drawn. These boundaries were refined them by assessing their local context including the location of community buildings, local street names, parks, sports clubs, and housing estate names.

• **Stage 3 (Desktop Refinement).** A Walkability analysis was carried out to further enhance the process, and to help better refine each boundary to "real time" 10 minute walkability. This process measured the real time walkable distance on the local road network using a spatial analysis process that defined the walkable area from each neighbourhood centre. These real time walking bands were then layered over and compared with existing Small Areas (SAs), forming the first iteration of neighbourhood boundaries.





• **Stage 4 (Consultation Refinement):** Following the desktop refinement a series of consultations was carried to better reflect the nature of each neighbourhood boundary. The Community Culture and Placemaking Directorate of Cork City Council reviewed each neighbourhood and consulted internally and externally in an effort to better define the neighbourhoods. This included engaging with Cork City's RAPID coordinators, community workers and other members of the team to better understand the working geographies of each neighbourhood. Refinements to each boundary were made based on this process.

As a result of this process, a collection of 44 neighbourhood boundaries have been established that reflect both tangible administrative and data based boundaries, as well accounting for the softer, social factors and on the ground realities of neighbourhoods within Cork City. The final report has been centred around the methodology used to define Cork City's 44 neighbourhoods, providing a rich evidence base of the network of neighbourhoods and communities within the City.

Additional Note:

















Pobal HP Deprivation Index, Relative Score



% Distribution of Occupied Housing by Neighbourhood






