‘That City Council would consider installing a pedestrian crossing be it a zebra or signalized crossing near the new bridge at the end of the cycleway/walkway on Curraheen Road, Bishopstown to facilitate the continuation of this wonderful amenity to Halldene and to provide the workers at the nearby industrial estate a safe passage to crossover this road.’

‘That Cork City Council would carry out a plebiscite at Greenwood Estate Togher to get the opinions of residents to the introduction of traffic calming measures in certain parts of this estate as residents are very concerned about the recent increase of speeding traffic and are really concerned for the young children and elderly residents that are living in this estate’
