#### Statement:

It is our responsibility to:

- o Ensure compliance with the all regulations pertaining to food waste;
- Ensure that any producer supplying food is compliant with the appropriate provisions of the Regulations;
- Prepare and submit to Cork City Council's Planning Department a Food Waste Management Plan 30 days prior to the event.
- Prepare and submit to Cork City Council's Planning Department a Food Waste
   Implementation Plan within 28 days of the event being held.

Food waste segregation will be achieved by providing for the separation of food waste bin(s) for use by all consumers of food.

Bins will be colour coded and labelled to inform visitors where the food waste should be deposited. Separate receptacles for waste and recyclable materials will be colour coded and labelled so as to prevent contamination.

All producers/Trade Stand holders will be asked to limit the use of disposable items and packaging where possible to limit waste. Producers supplying food will be informed of their obligations and the waste management arrangements in relation to food waste. All producers

are required to segregate and manage their own waste.

#### **Food Waste Profile:**

Anticipated Organic Waste:	0.5 tonnes Cooked and uncooked food (Dairy, Meat, Fish, Plant based) will be served at the Show. Consumer waste is limited to purchased but uneaten food.
Waste Oils (edible oil and fat):	None (all vendors are responsible for disposing of their own waste offsite).

### **Waste Collection Facilities:**

All waste generated at the show will be source segregated.

This includes food waste that is generated during food preparation, served by traders supplying food and food waste generated by consumers of food at the Show.

We will have cleaning staff on site throughout the day to ensure that food wheelie bins are serviced regularly and when nearing capacity removed to the holding area so as not to become a health hazard.

Food waste will be collected by an authorised collector and transferred to an authorised treatment process. The waste collector will have appropriate Waste Collection Permits.
