1. **STATUTORY ITEMS**

1.1 **SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL – BISHOPSTOWN COMMUNITY SCHOOL – SECTION 38 APPROVAL**

On the proposal of Comhairleoir G. Kelleher, seconded by Comhairleoir C. Finn, An Chomhairle considered and approved the report and recommendation of the Director of Services, Roads & Environment Operations, dated 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024, following public consultation, on the proposed Safe Routes to School – Bishopstown Community School pursuant to Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, as amended by Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009.

1.2 **SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL – GLANMIRE COMMUNITY COLLEGE – SECTION 38 APPROVAL**

On the proposal of Comhairleoir J. Maher, seconded by Comhairleoir M. Nugent, An Chomhairle considered and approved the report and recommendation of the Director of Services, Roads & Environment Operations, dated 20<sup>th</sup> May 2024, following public consultation, on the proposed Safe Routes to School – Glanmire Community College pursuant to Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, as amended by Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009.

1.3 **CAPITAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME: 5 SMITHGROVE TERRACE, MIDDLE GLANMIRE ROAD, CORK - SHANBALLY HOUSING ASSOCIATION CLG**

An Chomhairle considered and approved the report of the Director of Services, Housing Delivery & Regeneration, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 in relation to a loan facility for Shanbally Housing Association CLG in respect of the provision of five units of accommodation at 5 Smithgrove Terrace, Middle Glanmire Road, Cork.

On the proposal of Comhairleoir J. Kavanagh, seconded by Comhairleoir T. Fitzgerald, An Chomhairle further agreed to adopt the following Resolution:-

“Resolved that, pursuant to the provision of Section 6 of the Housing (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1992, a loan facility not exceeding €1,256,490 be granted to Shanbally Housing Association CLG, subject to the terms of the Capital Assistance Scheme for the provision of 5 one bed units of accommodation at 5 Smithgrove Terrace, Middle Glanmire Road, Cork.”

1.4 **CAPITAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME: 20 GOLDSMITH’S AVENUE, RICHMOND HILL, CORK - GALTAN CLG**

An Chomhairle considered and approved the report of the Director of Services, Housing Delivery & Regeneration, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 in relation to a loan facility for Galtan CLG in respect of the provision of one unit of accommodation at 20 Goldsmith’s Avenue, Richmond Hill, Cork.

On the proposal of Comhairleoir J. Sheehan, seconded by Comhairleoir T. Fitzgerald, An Chomhairle further agreed to adopt the following Resolution:-

“Resolved that, pursuant to the provision of Section 6 of the Housing (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1992, a loan facility not exceeding €225,744.49 be granted to Galtan CLG, subject to the terms of the Capital Assistance Scheme for the provision of 1 two bed unit of accommodation at 20 Goldsmith’s Avenue, Richmond Hill, Cork.”

1.5 **CAPITAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME: 6, 7, 10, WATERCOURSE MEWS, WATERCOURSE ROAD, CORK - FOCUS HOUSING ASSOCIATION CLG**

An Chomhairle considered and approved the report of the Director of Services, Housing Delivery & Regeneration, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 in relation to a loan facility for Focus Housing Association CLG in respect of the provision of three units of accommodation at 6, 7, 10, Watercourse Mews, Watercourse Road, Cork.

On the proposal of Comhairleoir D. Boylan, seconded by Comhairleoir T. Moloney, An Chomhairle further agreed to adopt the following Resolution:-

“Resolved that, pursuant to the provision of Section 6 of the Housing (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1992, a loan facility not exceeding €1,138,500 be granted to Focus Housing Association CLG, subject to the terms of the Capital Assistance Scheme for the provision of 2 three bed units and 1 four bed unit of accommodation at 6, 7, 10, Watercourse Mews, Watercourse Road, Cork.”
