Statement:

It is our responsibility to:

- o Ensure compliance with the all regulations pertaining to waste;
- Prepare and submit to Cork City Council's Planning Department a Waste Management Plan 30 days prior to the event.
- Prepare and submit to Cork City Council's Planning Department a Waste Implementation Plan within 28 days of the event being held.

Waste segregation will be achieved by providing appropriate, clearly labelled and colour coded waste, recycling and food waste receptacles. All producers/trade stand holders will be asked to limit the use of disposable items and packaging where possible to limit waste. All Traders/Exhibitors will be informed of their obligations and the waste management arrangements in place for the duration of the show, including set-up and take down. All producers are required to segregate and manage their own waste.

All sanitary waste (human and animal) will be managed in accordance with legislative obligations, particularly in relation to public health and environmental matters.

Waste Collection Facilities:

All waste generated at the Show will be source segregated.

We will have cleaning staff on site throughout the day to ensure that wheelie bins are serviced regularly and when nearing capacity removed to the holding area so as not to become a health hazard. Appropriate skips will be provided for the disposal of waste with separate skips being provided for general, recyclable and food waste.

All straw bedding used by animals will be removed from site each evening.

All Portaloos will be emptied each evening and the contents taken off-site.

All waste will be collected by authorised collector(s) and transferred to an authorised treatment process. The waste collector will have appropriate Waste Collection Permits.

There will be a road-brush in attendance to minimise the effect of debris (mud) on the public highway.
